Bayside High School NJROTC is requesting School Board approval to conduct a field trip to Marine Corps Base, Quantico VA, and Washington DC, 22 – 26 Apr 2009.

Educational Activity: BHS NJROTC is providing an excellent opportunity for 44 cadets to tour Marine Corps Base Quantico on 23 Apr, to include HMX-1 (President's helicopter squadron), Weapons Training Battalion, Night Integrated Training Environment Facility and the K9 Training Unit. On 24 April, the cadets will tour the National Museum of the Marine Corps in the morning, and be in Washington DC for tours of the Capitol, Arlington National Cemetery for a wreath laying at the Tomb of the Unknowns, the Smithsonian Institute, and returning to Quantico in the evening. On 25 April we will return to Washington for tours of the Capitol and numerous National monuments and museums.

Transportation: Participants will travel by charter bus, provided by Travel Lynx Inc, a school board approved transportation company, (44 cadets and 5 adult chaperones)

Lodging: Participants will be staying at the Crossroads Inn on MCB Quantico on 23-24 Apr 2009.

Participants: This trip will be limited to Naval Science I, II, III, and IV Cadets that are in excellent standing with the school and unit in academics and behavior. Chaperones are LtCol Livingston, Chief Sefchick, June Sefchick, Erin Gideon and Joyce Cochran. All Chaperones are either teachers or fingerprinted volunteers. Itinerary is on following page.

Cost: Cadets conducted fundraising activities during Aug-Dec 08 to defer individual expenses.

Transportation: \$6,500, Travel Lynx Inc.


Berthing: \$2,100
