

RESOLUTION
of the
BREVARD COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD
2008-09 CATEGORICAL FUNDING FLEXIBILITY

WHEREAS, the STATE OF FLORIDA has provided limited appropriations to school districts for the current fiscal year; and,

WHEREAS, the revenues appropriated for the BREVARD COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT have been limited and would severely impact the operation of the district's instructional program; and,

WHEREAS, the BREVARD COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT STAFF has reviewed all spending priorities to verify the areas that would least impact the classroom programs; and,

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 1011.71 (6) (b), provides for flexibility to expend categorical funds allocated to a school district from state appropriations; and,

WHEREAS, the BREVARD COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD is required to adopt a resolution declaring that the categorical funds represented below are needed to maintain academic classroom instruction;

THEREFORE, be it resolved, that the BREVARD COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD finds that there is an urgent need to use the authority granted in statute to use certain categorical funds to maintain classroom instruction and, authorizes the Superintendent to transfer said funds for such purposes.
