## GENERAL EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT (GED) TESTS

A person who is at least sixteen (16) years of age and not enrolled in an elementary or secondary school may be permitted to take the General Education Development (GED) tests upon submission of a statement of justification recommended by the Superintendent's designee and approved by the Superintendent's designee. The statement of justification shall be based on at least one of the following circumstances:

- A. The candidate justifies a need to be employed which would prevent school attendance; or
- B. The candidate is a parent who does not have access to child care; or
- C. The candidate justifies health condition(s) which would prevent school attendance.
