

CREDITS FROM OTHER SCHOOLS

In recognizing its responsibility to uphold the minimum educational standards of the State of Florida, the Board establishes the following policy and criteria regarding the transfer of credits from other schools. The District reserves the right to assess such transfer students in order to determine proper placement and to be assured the student can demonstrate the learnings which are prerequisite to a placement.

Acceptance of transfer work or credits (grades 9-12) shall be in accordance with State Board Rules and Standards of the Commission on Secondary Schools, Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

In accordance with State law, the same guiding principles used to determine student competency in required courses and credits toward graduation shall be applied when evaluating the work of students from out of State or out of country. Strategies for assuring student competencies in required subject areas and for meeting course requirements for promotion or graduation shall be based on these guiding principles.

The Student Progression Plan (SPP) adopted for the school year is incorporated by reference.
