

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS

An eleventh or twelfth grade student transferring to this District out-of-state or from another country shall be permitted to graduate on schedule and receive a standard high school diploma with fewer than the prescribed number of credits provided the following conditions are met. The student shall:

- A. have successfully completed the normal requirements of the school district, state, or country from which s/he is transferring;
- B. have taken and successfully completed a full schedule of courses, including as many required courses as possible, during the period of attendance at the graduating school;
- C. have earned a 2.0 grade point average; and
- D. have demonstrated proficiency in Reading and Mathematics by either earning passing cores on the Grade 10/Retake FCAT Reading and Mathematics tests or through a standardized test score that is concordant with the passing score on the FCAT as set forth in State law.

The Student Progression Plan (SPP) adopted for the school year is incorporated by reference.
