

SUMMER SCHOOL

The Board may conduct a summer program of academic instruction for students in grades ~~9~~ K-12 remediation in Reading, Math, English, Science, and Social Studies and those ESE students needing extended school year service, as identified in their I.E.P., ~~at the K-12 level,~~ for resident students of this District, and other students as approved. ~~In addition to the 9-12 remedial and K-12 exceptional student education summer program, the~~ The District may choose to implement summer enhancement programs, contingent upon Board approval.

With regard to transportation, the Board accepts responsibility for full-time ESE students, as required in Florida Board of Education Rule 6A-6.03028(3)(i).

The Superintendent shall be responsible for developing administrative procedures for the operation of the summer program which shall be consistent with Board policies and not conflict in any way with the administration of the regular school sessions of the District.

The Superintendent shall develop and update as needed administrative procedures to implement this policy.
