

**INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
ECKERD YOUTH ALTERNATIVES, INC.**

**d/b/a Eckerd**

**AND  
BREVARD COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT;  
TITLE I**

The goal of this interagency agreement is to enhance school safety through the provision of services designed to promote/increase conflict resolution skills among third, fourth and fifth grade students at Endeavour, and Riverview elementary schools. Services will be provided in accordance with provisions of "Community Juvenile Justice System Act of 1993" as created in Chapter 39.025 and Chapter 860.1545, Florida Statutes.

**A. Eckerd Agrees with Brevard County School District, Title I Program to:**

1. Provide trained staff to work with school staff and identified "at-risk youth".
2. Fully orient all school personnel of the expectations and limits of program services.
3. Provide necessary materials to program participants to support success of the program.
4. Make available to parents: parent meetings, educational materials, and linkage to support services.
5. Promote and support goals of the schools through program services.
6. Remain responsible for the actions and behavior of EYA Early Intervention Program staff during school related activities.
7. Share information on youth served to the extent that local and federal laws on confidentiality permit.

**B. The Brevard County School District, Title One Program, agrees to provide the following:**


1. A pool of screened third, fourth and fifth grade youth determined by school personnel to be "at risk" for drop out, involvement with the juvenile justice system, drug and alcohol and severe school behavior problems.
2. Adequate space at the school during school hours for Hi-Five staff to perform program services.
3. Collaborative teacher and administrative support to Hi-Five staff.
4. Provide data and information on program youth to the extent local, state and federal laws on confidentiality permit

5. Provide cross-training opportunities between teachers and program staff

**C. Eckerd and the Brevard County School District; Title I Program mutually agree to:**

1. Shared responsibility in the planning and scheduling of activities and program services.
2. Meet together when disagreements arise in order to develop agreed upon solutions.  
When the above agencies cannot arrive at agreement, the issue will be referred to the Together In Partnership (TIP) for recommended resolution
3. Review this agreement in June of each year to evaluate and determine needed changes.

Eckerd Youth Alternatives, Inc. and the Brevard County School District; Title I Program agree to the above procedures for the operation of the Eckerd Early Intervention's Hi-Five Program for the dates of July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012.
